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ADJECTIVES

Adjectives are words that describe. They tell us something more about a noun/pronoun.

In the sentence:

She is wearing a pink frock.



The word "pink" describes the noun "frock." Hence PINK = adjective.

What kind of frock? Answer: PINK. Hence 'pink' is the adjective.



MORE EXAMPLES:

1. I can see TALL trees.

Q: What kind of trees?

Answer: TALL (tall = adjective)

2. The camel is a CROOKED animal.

Q: What kind of animal?

Answer: CROOKED (crooked = adjective)

3. My friend lives in a BIG house.

O: What kind of house?

Answer: BIG (big = adjective)

4. We are going for a LONG vacation.

Q: What kind of vacation?

Answer: LONG (long = adjective)
