**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'is' and 'she' hence the tag is negative.
3. (B)  
**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'is' and 'man' hence the tag is negative.
4. (C)  
**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'can' and 'he' hence the tag is negative.
5. (A)  
**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'shall' and 'we' hence the tag is negative.
6. (B)  
**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'have' and 'you' hence the tag is negative.
7. (C)  
**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'will' and 'Sunita' hence the tag is negative.
8. (D)  
**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'may' and 'I' hence the tag is negative.
9. (A)  
**Exp:** The sentence is negative with 'are' and 'there' hence the tag is affirmative.
10. (C)  
**Exp:** The sentence is negative with 'is' and 'tea' hence the tag is affirmative.

11. (D)

**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'are' and 'books' hence the tag is negative.

12. (C)

**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'could' and 'you' hence the tag is negative.

13. (A)

**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'has' and 'match' hence the tag is negative.

14. (C)

**Exp:** The sentence is negative with 'will' and 'girls' hence the tag is affirmative.

15. (C)

**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'is' and 'William' hence the tag is negative.

16. (B)

**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'has' and 'Jack' hence the tag is negative.

17. (B)

**Exp:** The sentence is negative with 'did' and 'baby' hence the tag is affirmative.

18. (B)

**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'won' and 'horse' hence the tag is negative.

19. (B)

**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'change' and 'hidden subject - you' hence the tag is negative. The sentence is imperative; hence 'won't' is used in the tag.

20. (D)

**Exp:** The sentence is affirmative with 'can' and 'Sheila' hence the tag is negative.
