Answer Key:

1. C

Explanation: 'Yesterday' indicates the past tense; hence 'were watching' is correct.

2. B

Explanation: 'Disturb' indicates the present tense; hence 'is studying' is correct.

3. A

Explanation: 'Are' indicates the present tense; hence 'are playing' is correct.

4. C

Explanation: 'Tomorrow' indicates the future tense; hence 'will be arriving' is correct.

5. D

Explanation: 'Last week' indicates the past tense; hence 'was trying' is correct.

6. D

Explanation: 'Sentence 1' indicates the present tense; hence 'are going' is correct.

7. B

Explanation: 'Next year' indicates the future tense; hence 'will be studying' is correct.

8. D

Explanation: 'Last night' indicates the past tense; hence 'were enjoying' is correct.

9. C

Explanation: 'Next month' indicates the future tense; hence 'will be promoting' is correct.

10. A

Explanation: 'Now' indicates the present tense; hence 'is baking' is correct.
