1. B

Explanation: 'We' is a plural subject & 'last week' indicates past tense, hence 'were' is correct.

2. C

Explanation: 'Friend' is a singular subject & 'next month' indicates future tense; hence 'will be' is correct.

3. C

Explanation: 'It' is a singular subject & 'yesterday' indicates past tense; hence 'was' is correct.

4. D

Explanation: 'Boy' is a singular subject & 'part 2 of the sentence' indicates future tense; hence 'will be' is correct.

5. B

Explanation: 'Saplings' is a plural subject & 'last year' indicates past tense; hence 'were' is correct.

6. A

Explanation: 'Sonal' is a singular subject & 'last night' indicates past tense; hence 'was' is correct.

7. B

Explanation: 'Toys' is a plural subject & 'yesterday' indicates past tense; hence 'were' is correct.

8. D

Explanation: 'We' is a plural subject & 'next year' indicates future tense; hence 'will be' is correct.

9. B

Explanation: 'Tomorrow' is a singular subject & 'tomorrow' also indicates future tense; hence 'will be' is correct.

10.C

Explanation: 'Mohan and Sonali' is a plural subject & 'last year' indicates past tense; hence 'were' is correct.
