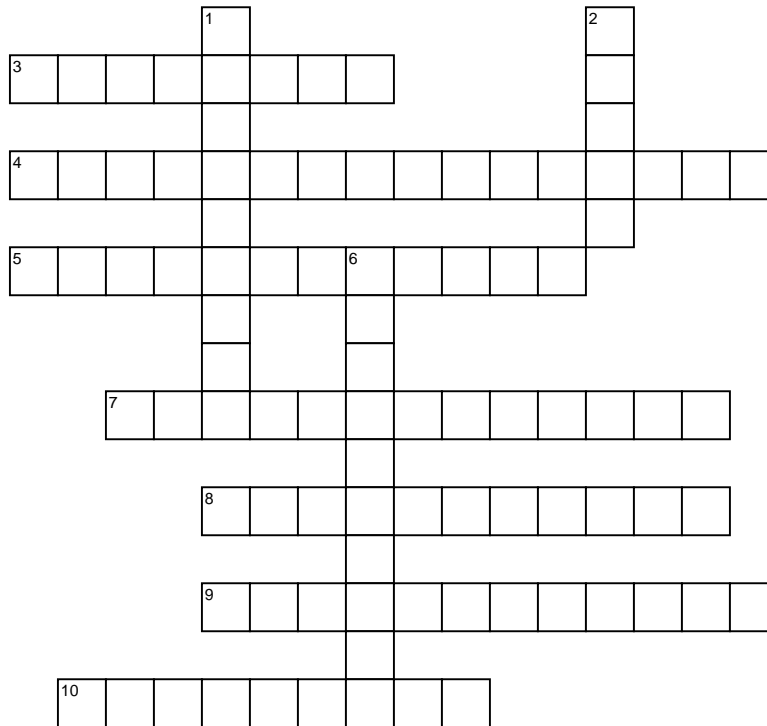

### ACROSS

- 3 This great monument built in pure white marble by Shahjahan, the Mughal emperor.
- 4 Largest coral reef, located in northeast Australia in the Coral sea.
- 5 Located out in the Pacific Ocean and a special territory of Chile, It holds Moai statues that are the only thing left of a culture that once lived here. The stones that attract visitors to this island are made out of volcanic ash.
- 7 They were built by Nebuchadnezzar II. The gardens consisted of a series of terraces at about 23-91 m above the ground level and water was piped down from the reservoir at the top of the terraces.
- 8 Located in southern Peru. It is famously referred to as the "Lost City of the Incas." It was also named one of the New Seven Wonders of the World in 2007.
- 9 Highest point on the surface of the earth located in Himalayan mountain ranges.
- 10 This elliptical structure is located in the center of Rome. It could seat nearly 50,000 spectators .

### DOWN

- 1 The ancient temple to Athena stands as a symbol of the power of Athens and a testament to Greek civilization. Moreover, it provides a great view of Athens and nearby ruins.
- 2 Carved into a canyon in Arabah, Jordan. It was located in a valley surrounded by sandstone mountains. It was recently named one of the New Seven Wonders of the World.
- 6 Located near Salisbury, England, this megalithic structure is over 3,000 years old, and its stones come all the way from Wales.
