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6) A farmer has planted 5440 rows of corn. 4641 of the rows died in a drought. How many rows remain?

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18) Sunil walked 7669 metres east, then turned around and walked 4621 metres west. How far was Sunil from where he started?

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19) The construction worker used 7786 nails for the front of the house and 2560 nails for the back of the house. How many nails did he use in all?

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20) The salesman visited 4592 houses on Tuesday and 7224 houses on Thursday. How many houses did he visit?
