
Natural Calamities

- **2** A violent wind which has a circular movement, especially found in the West Atlantic Ocean.
- **6** A strong wind in a desert carrying a large amount of sand.
- **7** When there is not enough food for a great number of people, causing illness and death.
- 8 A flash of bright light in the sky which is produced by electricity moving between clouds or from clouds to the ground.
- **9** An extremely large wave caused by movement of the Earth under the sea.
- **12** A mass of rock and earth moving suddenly and quickly down a steep slope.
- 13 A sudden heavy fall of hail.
- 14 To fill or become covered with water, especially in a way that causes problems.
- **15** A strong dangerous wind which forms itself into an upside-down spinning cone and is able to destroy buildings as it moves across the ground.
