



It is the part of a gas stove that produces flame.



Stove top:



It is the top part of a stove where food is cooked in pans.

Gas ring:



- 1. It is a round piece of metal with holes in it.
- 2. It is on the top of a gas stove.
- 3. Here the gas is lit to produce the flame for cooking.

Lighter:

It is a hand-held device for creating a flame.



Sandwich maker:



It is an electric equipment used for making sandwiches.

Food processer:



It is an electrical appliance that is used to mix, blend, chop or cut food items.

Oven glove:



- 1. These are gloves made of thick material.
- 2. They are used for holding hot dishes.



Chimney:



- 1. It is a machine through which smoke is carried up away from fire.
- 2. The smoke is carried through the roof of the building.
- 3. The part of this chimney is above the roof.

Microwave:



- 1. It is a type of an oven.
- 2. It cooks or heats food very quickly.
- 3. It uses electromagnetic waves rather than heat.

Splash back:



- 1. It is a surface behind a sink or stove.
- 2. It protects the wall from liquids.



Knife block:



- 1. It is a small block usually of wood.
- 2. It is used to store knives.

Knife:

- 1. It is a sharp blade with handle.
- 2. It is used for cutting and chopping vegetables and fruits.

Counter:



It is a flat surface in kitchen for preparation of food.



Kitchen unit:



- 1. Special furniture made for the kitchen to hold all types of kitchenware.
- 2. There are cupboards and shelves that match every need.

Kitchen roll:

It is an electrical appliance that is used to toast slices of bread.

Tap:



It is a device for controlling the flow of water from a pipe into a sink.

Dish cloth:



It is a cloth used for washing dishes.

Electrical Kettle:



- 1. It is an electrical appliance with a lid, handle and a spout.
- 2. It is used for boiling water.

Dish washer:



It is a machine for washing utensils.



Water purifier:



It is an electrical device that removes harmful substances like bacteria, virus and extra salts from water.

Tea towel:



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It is a small towel used for drying cups, plates, knives, etc. after they have been washed after use.

Draining board:




- 1. It is the area next to the kitchen sink.
- 2. Here cups, plates, etc. are put for the water to drain off, after they have been washed.



Breakfast bar:



It is a place in the kitchen where breakfast is served and eaten.



Pan:



- 1. It is a container usually made of metal.
- 2. It has a handle or handles.
- 3. It is used for cooking food.



Bowl:



- 1. It is a deep round dish with a wide open top.
- 2. It is used especially for holding food or liquid.

Spoon:

1. It is a tool that has a handle with a shallow bowl at the end.

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2. It is used for stirring, serving and eating food.

Tumbler:



- 1. It is a glass for drinking out of, with a flat bottom.
- 2. It has straight sides and no handle.

Plate:



It is a flat, usually round dish that you put food on.



Wok:



- 1. It is a large, shallow pan shaped like a bowl.
- 2. It is used for cooking food especially chinese recipes.





- 1. It is a strong metal pot with a tight lid.
- 2. It cooks food quickly by steam under high pressure.

Fork:

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- 1. It is a tool with handle and three or four sharp prongs.
- 2. It is used for piercing, picking up and eating food.
